SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL PLAN

The season of winter is almost upon us. The following plan is a reminder for residents that will help the street department keep our streets safe and clean.

The Village of Arcanum snow and ice removal begins with the major traffic areas

- Highest Priority: Emergency travel for fire, medical and police
- Second Priority: Schools and roadways which facilitate traffic flow in and out of subdivisions and the village
- Last Priority: Courts, alleys and other residential streets

The reason for the priority status is due to the nature of availability in the case of emergency

PLOWING

Until snowfall reaches a depth of 2", plowing is not productive. After accumulations reach 2", plowing will begin with salt being spread. In intense storms, salt spreading will be discontinued as plowing continues. After the priority areas are cleaned, the areas against the curb are cleaned to allow melting material to run off to gutters.

SALT SPREADING

The above priority plan will be followed with salt spreading. Salt spreading is used primarily to melt the first fallen snow and reduce the potential of build-up of frozen material.

SNOW SHOVELING

Residents and businesses are responsible for their own walkways. The snow around and leading to mailboxes must be clear for mail personnel to deliver. The Street Department recommends that snow be shoveled away from the roadway and to the right of the driveway to prevent snow plows from covering shoveled areas.
