The radio system is changing county wide for all emergency/law enforcement agencies to 800 MARCS radios. This system cannot set off our Tornado Sirens. We have entered into an agreement with the City of Greenville to have the Greenville Communications Center activate our sirens. They are doing this free of charge. The service is basically the same as when the Sheriff's Department activated the sirens.

We are in the process of purchasing a street sweeper from Greenville. This is a much needed machine for the street department.

I haven't commented much lately regarding the construction of the automated sewer plant. Construction has been running on schedule and we haven't had any hiccups, so the completion date is still set for May, 2019. Building Crafts has been an excellent contractor to work with.
