Tax Department Update

The State and Local tax deadline has been extended to May 17, 2021. Residents requiring in-person assistance are welcome to come to the Administration Office during regular business hours. The lobby is limited to one person at a time. There will be a sign-in sheet at the first window and you will be asked to wait outside or in your vehicle until called.

Appointments are available by calling the Tax Department at 692-8500. Walks-ins are welcome; however, those with appointments will be served first. Please bring your W-2, the 1st page of the Federal 1040 and any applicable schedules.

Hydrant Flushing

The Village Utility Department will be flushing hydrants on April 13 & 14 between 7am-4pm. This may cause some water discoloration, so residents are advised to check the water before washing, cooking, etc. If needed, make-up days are April 20 & 21.
