## **AUTOMATIC PAYMENT PLAN**

For my benefit and convenience, Arcanum Water & Light is hereby authorized to automatically deduct from my checking account the amount of my utility bill each month on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the month or first business day following the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month. I agree to be bound by the rules set forth below, in addition to the bank's regular rules governing checking/savings accounts.

## **RULES**

- 1. The term "bill" means Electric, Sewer, Water and Refuse
- 2. Depositor agrees that the bank's right with respect to each bill shall be the same as if each bill were a check drawn on the bank and signed personally by the depositor and that the bank be fully protected in honoring each bill
- 3. This authority is to remain in effect until revoked upon 30 day written notice by the bank, utility company or depositor.
- 4. Bank's sole responsibility and duty shall be to charge the depositor's account for the amount issued from the utility company.
- 5. Bank is under no obligation to notify depositor of either payment or dishonor of utility bills. Bills will be returned unpaid to the utility company if depositor's account does not contain sufficient funds to cover the amount of said bill. If payment is denied from the bank, customer will be notified and responsible to make payment by check, cash, money order or online prior to the 15<sup>th</sup> to avoid penalties.
