



Tax Department Update

When completing the 2021 Village of Arcanum Income Tax Return, please remember to:

- *Sign your return.
- *Attach page 1 of your Federal 1040.
- *Include all W2's, 1099's and schedules.
- *Include your full payment.

All residents 18 and over residing within the Village corporation must file a tax return. If you retired in 2021, then you must file a final return. If you filed a final return previously and have no earned income, then you are not required to file.

New This Year - Online Filing

Residents will have the option this year to upload tax documents online thru the Village website under Income Tax. Online Income Tax filing will be available around the middle of February. More details to come in the February Newsletter!
