2021 Tax Deadline: April 18, 2022

When completing the 2021 Village of Arcanum Income Tax Return, please remember to:

*Sign your return.

*Attach page 1 of your Federal 1040.
*Include all W2's, 1099's and schedules.
*Include your full payment.

All residents 18 and over residing within the Village corporation must file a tax return. If you retired in 2021, then you must file a final return. If you filed a final return previously and have no earned income, then you are not required to file.

Arcanum does not give credit for other city taxes withheld.

Taxes can be filed through the mail, brought into the office or through our website. Log on to our website at www.villageofarcanum.com

Click the Income Tax tab and then the Online Filing.

Follow the instructions to file online. You can upload copies of your W-2's, 1099's and your Federal 1040 page 1 and if you have Schedules C & E that need to be uploaded to complete your return.

Remember to SIGN YOUR RETURN!

Payments can be made online through the link on the Income Tax tab or you can still pay with cash or check at the office or mail to PO Box 157 Arcanum, OH 45304 If you have questions regarding who is required to file go to the Residential Tax Forms page under General forms.
