- REMINDER: **<u>DO NOT</u>** place grass clippings and twigs in with leaves. <u>They will not be picked up.</u> It will be YOUR responsibility to bag or put in trash containers for normal Rumpke pickup.
- Leaves <u>naturally</u> falling on your property from neighboring trees are your responsibility to pick up. Placing these leaves back onto your neighbors' property is inappropriate and illegal. Please blow them to the curb for the Village leaf collection.
- November 3rd Town Hall forum Last chance for Q & A with the Police Chief on the upcoming police levy.
- New Zoning changes effective Oct 1st. (Any questions, contact VA Bill Kessler)
  - Establishment of B2 Business District.
  - Eliminated all Agricultural zoning.
  - Changes to downtown business/residential zoning.
  - Exterior building color MUST be communicated to Village prior to painting.
  - Fence permits for new and replacement fencing must follow new zoning rules.
  - Vehicles must be licensed and operable to be parked on the street or property.
- Exciting news The Tax Department can now accept <u>credit card payments in the OFFICE</u>. The online credit card payment option is still available.


