<u>Village Updates & News</u>

Flock System - Chief Ballinger talked about the Flock System in last month's newsletter, and I'm glad to say that the Flock System was approved by Council and should be up and running sometime in March.

Grocery store – Due to the economy and higher interest rates, the acquisition process has seen a few delays. The Village will continue to meet with them and we are hopeful that a few financial incentives will further aid our efforts in providing this amenity to our residents.

The 2022 overall year end reports reflect a 1.2% increase in tax revenues received over 2021 for the General Fund.

Recently a feasibility study was performed by Sawvel Engineering that showed that the Village Water Fund does not have adequate funds to sustain forecasted costs over the next five -year period. With the continued increased costs and the last water rate increase in 2020, the Utility Committee discussed a plan to increase the minimum service fee. Council has approved an increase in the flat rate service fee and a water rate restructure, and customers will see these changes on their April bill. A complete listing of all service fee increases for all size water lines can be obtained from the Village Utility Clerk or by visiting the Village website. Please note that your sewer rates are not affected by these changes.

Utility Superintendent Randy Baker, is asking every household to have a water shut off valve installed inside their home if they do not already have one. Having a water shut off is not only for your protection, but also saves unnecessary costs and time.

Administration has been working on a revised ordinance to present to Council regulating solicitors/peddlers in the Village of Arcanum. More information to follow in the coming months.

We have received several inquiries regarding the "For Sale" signs placed along Alt 49 and North Main St. This real estate is in the early preliminary stages thru a realtor. The land is zoned Residential R1C along North Main out to Hollansburg-Sampson Rd. and Business B-3 along Alt 49.

The Park & Recreation Committee is still collecting bottle caps for new park benches. Caps can be turned in to the Administration Office, Fourman's Variety and the Arcanum Library. Please be sure to be turning in clean caps only. We want to thank everyone for participating in this program.

February may be the shortest month of the year, but a lot is packed into the next 28 days with many popular holidays, historical events, celebrations and occasions dedicated to important causes. You may all be surprised all of what really occurs in February if you look it up!

Tax Department Update

When completing the 2022 Village of Arcanum Income Tax Return, please remember to:

*Sign your return. *Attach page 1 of your Federal 1040. *Include all W2's, 1099's and schedules. *Include your full payment.

All residents 18 and over residing within the Village corporation must file a tax return. If you retired in 2022, then you must file a final return. If you filed a final return previously and have no earned income, then you are not required to file.

Tax returns are available online or in the Administration Office. Online filing is available through the website @ www.villageofarcanum.com.
