The Village Planning Commission worked over a year on rewriting the new Zoning Code, with input considered from surrounding communities. Therefore, we are trying to be proactive in any situation that could arise in our community that could decrease the value of one's property, such as a neighboring purple, polka dots, neon yellow or green etc., house and/or building color. Rest assured, we will work with you and be practical.

If you have not already heard of the efforts being made by the Darke County Association of Fire Chiefs campaign, the following is a brief summary. CHIEFS' (Communities Helping Improve the Education of the Fire Service) campaign is for the development of a Darke County Regional Fire Training Facility. This facility will greatly improve the continuing education for 21 Darke County fire departments, including Arcanum, by providing a safe and realistic firefighter training facility that will positively impact the emergency services provided by all departments in all communities served.
