A Message from the Mayor's Office

We had a very busy and fruitful garage sale week in the Village from the favorable comments I have heard. The weather so far this summer for the pool has not been the greatest, however, the new food items have been a huge hit with the kids. Fun Fact: Did you know that the Village pool is almost 50 years old! We are very fortunate that our pool has held up as well as it has, and we should pride ourselves in knowing that we have been able to extend the life of the pool 20+ years longer than expected. However, as much the Village loves our old fashioned 50-year-old pool, patch work and repairs are becoming more costly and unsustainable. The Village will continue to apply for grants for a new pool; however, the Village match dollars would be very high and would be monies that the Village currently does not have based on our current tax base and levies. With that said, the Village is very aware that all good things must come to an end, but until that day comes for our little old-fashioned pool the Village will do everything we can to continue to open the pool.

In other news, the Village finally received the grant for the complete reconstruction of East First Street and East Street with construction to begin in 2024. Residents will begin seeing some prep work possibly yet this fall.

I have received several inquiries regarding the opening of the grocery store in the old hardware building. The Village Utility Department has changed out the transformers to accommodate their needs. We contacted the owner three weeks ago and he stated he has obtained his liquor permit, but was still waiting on approval of his food prep license.

The Village has also been receiving complaints of trash receptacles being set out earlier than scheduled times with some residents not removing trash receptacles in the time allotted. You are permitted to set trash out on Wednesday afternoon and receptacles must be removed by Friday morning.

Just as a reminder, Council meetings are the second and last Tuesdays of every month at 7pm. Public Comments are at the beginning of the meeting for residents to share their thoughts and concerns with Council.

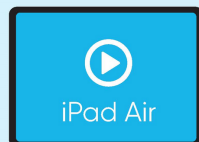

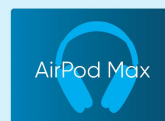
