# RCANUM A Message from the Mayor's Office

It's August!! My grandparents always told me that the older one gets, the faster time goes. No truer words have ever been spoken. We will soon be enjoying the fair, with school right around the corner.

Some updates to share with you:

I'm sorry to have stirred concerns on our pool, however, let me reassure you that the Village will continue to repair the pool walls annually, while diligently pursuing the most practical move forward. The future could be an Aquatic Center or Olympic style pool as we have now. However, YOU, the residents, will have the final say in the financial route taken, such as, grants - (requires Village match dollars in the millions), a levy, or any other possible funding avenues that become available.

Arcanum Nature Preserve - The south portion of the wooded area now has a path cleared and marked for casual walking. Benches are staggered throughout the trail, and a new, "Arcanum Nature Preserve at Ivester Park," sign is on the way. We are eagerly awaiting word on our ODNR grant, and if approved, the monies will be used to complete the expansion project. The Park Committee is looking for volunteers to help monitor and assist in maintaining our park. Volunteer form is on the Village website and Facebook page.

Pickleball courts - Due to unforeseen issues on the tennis courts, the basketball court at the ball diamonds will become multi-purpose for basketball and pickleball. Repairs and painting of the entire court will be completed by August 10th. There are plans to possibly turn the basketball court by the scout house in Ivester Park to multi-purpose as well.

Electric- The following information is supported by our Utility Superintendent. Past outages along with seconds and minutes of sporadic outages have all been a result of AES lines not being cleared of limbs and vegetation. The lines have reclosures, which allow up to 2 intermittent stoppages and startups, with the third causing an outage which requires clearing of the line. For example, if a limb brushes the line 1-2 times, it will trigger the flickering while trying to burn off the limb. If the limb remains on the line after the second trigger a total outage will occur, until a crew clears the obstruction from the line. In communicating with AES, they have committed to late summer/early fall for vegetation trimming to take place and repeated annually. The Village has been upgrading our electrical infrastructure from 2400kv to 7200kv in preparation for a new substation and additional power source allowing two feeds coming into town, thus making outages a rare occurrence. Questions about the project and plans, can be answered by contacting VA/Chief of Police, Marcus Ballinger.

Lastly, Jacob Banks formally resigned from Village Council effective August 18th. He will be greatly missed and has been a tremendous asset on council. He exemplified excellent leadership as Chairman of the Service and Leisure Committee, and his knowledge on the parks, pool, and streets will be missed. We wish to acknowledge his excellent service and wish his family the best of luck on their upcoming move.

August is thought of as the last month of summer fun, vacations, outings and parties, so enjoy August to the fullest.
