A Message from the Mayor's Office

Hard to believe that Easter has come and gone. Spring has officially sprung, but the temperature suggests otherwise. Some residents have already begun mowing grass and beautiful tulips are beginning to bloom. I'm curious as to how many were subjected to the traditional shenanigans for April Fools' Day!

For those that were not already aware, both of the Village operating replacement levies failed to pass. One failed by 3 votes and the other by 49 votes with 468 total votes cast. Council will be discussing what options are available for the November Election.

The pedestrian crossing lights at Sierra and Trojan Way have been installed and are operational. The new traffic light being placed on Main and Trojan Way, will be installed this summer and operational, prior to the start of the new school year. Upon completion, the school will provide a visual map for parents, students, and the community regarding these changes, as well as, educating the students on the changes and directions for the safest way to walk or ride home.

April's main attraction, the Solar Eclipse, will occur on April 8th at approximately 1:53pm - 4:25pm. Darke County EMA lists Arcanum at full totality at 3:08 pm, lasting for 3m 47.1s. The Darke County Parks District and Main Street Greenville are just a few organizations in Darke County that have festivities planned for the entire weekend leading up to the big event. If you have not already done so, please be sure to have the required glasses for viewing the Solar Eclipse.

Girl Scout Troop 3073 has attended several council meetings and received approval to install a GAGA pit in the park for their Bronze Award. These young ladies are still collecting caps, but have done exceptional in their cap collection so far, that installation is currently being planned for mid-April weather permitting.

The Scout House in Ivester Park is currently being renovated and will be available to rent this year by the community.

The Park & Recreation Committee and Planning Committee are collaborating on a design for the Arcanum Nature Preserve. Once completed, the plans will be given to the engineering firm for a project cost estimate. Follow the Arcanum Park & Recreation Committee Facebook page for updates and scheduled meetings. Who is ready for some Pickleball!! The nets for both parks will be put back up for the season in the next few days, and the tennis court resurfacing should be completed by the end of this month, with one half of the tennis courts being converted to a permanent pickleball court.

A big thank you to the T-N-R volunteers that have come forward, offering their time and services to help with the cat population within the Village. We hope to have this in full swing this month.

Village employees will be busy performing the utility changeover on the West end from 2400kv to 7200ky, replacing necessary catch basins, and preparing for the pool season. Pool Passes can be purchased beginning May 1st, and information regarding the pool can be found on the Village
