## RCANUM A Message from the Mayor's Office

August all ready? Where did the summer go? August seems to be one of the busiest times of summer, with the Brick Street Block Party, the GREAT Darke County Fair and preparing for the return to school.

Here are some updates on current Village projects:

The traffic light at Main Street & Trojan Avenue, along with new traffic lines marked on Trojan Avenue will be completed by the beginning of school.

The Village was fortunate to be awarded the Darke County Parks Grant in the amount of \$8k. These funds will go towards upgrading the fencing and dugout on one of the diamonds at the ball park. The plan is to try to upgrade one diamond each year until all diamonds have been completed, as long as the Village continues to be awarded the grant.

Grants - The Arcanum Police Department has been awarded a grant that will cover 75% of the cost for the purchase of three new vests and carriers for officers. The Village was also awarded an EPA grant that will cover the entire cost of closing six old unused wells.

Once again, there has been more damage and vandalism done to Ivester Park. The kids teeter totter has been vandalized with one teeter totter completely broken and the other graffitied. It goes without saying that the repairs to the teeter totter will be costly and unnecessary. I find it very disappointing that this keeps happening, and wonder whether the individuals responsible for the damage would stop, if they were forced to pay for the repairs out of their own allowance.

The Park & Recreation Committee, along with the Service & Leisure Committee, have come up with a few different names for each section of trail in the Arcanum Nature Preserve. Village residents are asked to please participate in the naming of the trails in YOUR park by returning the included insert to the office by August 31st. A survey link is available on the Village Facebook page.

The Park & Recreation Committee will be doing another "Adopt a Tree in Ivester Park", similar to what had previously been done in fall of 2022. This year individuals will have the option to purchase a whole tree or make a smaller monetary donation. Please see the back of this newsletter, or the Village Facebook page for more information.

The Darke County Parks Tour de Darke will be Sunday August 4th with participants choosing to ride 4 different routes ranging from 13 miles up to 65 miles. You may see some riders cruising thru the Village this Sunday as Ivester Park is a rest stop on the lower route.

I want to wish all the kids participating at fair good luck on all their projects and events! I'm sure many of us are already preparing a list of food vendors to visit during the fair.
