

# VILLAGE OF ARCANUM



Hopefully everyone had a blessed Christmas and a wonderful New Years! The early snow in December, made it a nice, beautiful, mild evening for the AABA "Christmas in the Park". Congrats to the winners of the decorating contest and Tree Raffle.

**2025 Village major accomplishments:** School traffic light, electric conversion from 2400 to 7200, beautiful sign erected for Ivester Park at Maple Lane, Ivester Park & Arcanum Nature Preserve Expansion Project, tax department to RITA, East 1st/East/Albright Streets Reconstructed Project, fiber optic available to residents, Certified Operators in the Wastewater Department. The Police Department officially completed their first recertification through the Ohio Collaborative, joined the Blue Envelope Program, and initiated the Safe Exchange Program.

These projects were not without major issues, however with our dedicated, committed and hardworking employees, they worked through all of them and persevered toward overall quality projects, all while maintaining the normal day-to-day operations and services our residents are accustomed to.

Thanks to all of you that cleaned up your properties to meet various zoning requirements. The Village has received many compliments on how nice the entire village looks. Your work does not go unnoticed.

**A few mentions for 2026:** Reconstruction of South High Street and downtown & ball park parking lot starting in the spring with an end of August completion date, electrical underground project planned for Greenmoor/Northmoor, installation of flow meters to detect leaks, switching software systems from CMI to Tyler Technology, catch basins on N. Main & E. South Streets, continual work on new pool designs, installation of the splash pad pending grant approval, and the Police Department is pursuing their next step for State accreditation.

None of this is accidental. They are intentional steps, long planning and hard earned by Council and village leadership to build a place where businesses want to invest and families want to put down lasting roots. We've come far, but the climb isn't over.

I want to address a concern that some residents have voiced regarding Marcus Ballinger filling the roles of both Village Administrator and Chief of Police. Those concerns are real, I hear them, and I respect them. When I asked him a couple years back if he would be willing to fill both roles, he graciously accepted the challenge. The truth is simple; this Village is moving forward in a positive manner! If I felt that he was being overworked and under achieving it would be addressed. I am a committed mayor and a go getter and want to get things accomplished. We have an active Council and a staff that takes service seriously. This all works because they all genuinely want to be here and build and improve the Village for the betterment of our residents. This dual role for Marcus is a special situation, and not necessarily long term, or setting a precedence. But for now, this arrangement works because of timing, trust, and the team we have in place.

2026 is here: delete negative people, forget your past, accept your mistakes and restart your life. Let's have a celebratory 2026.


